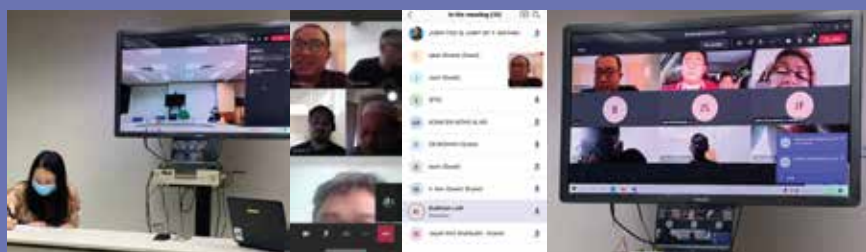
MYJICA EXCO MEETING

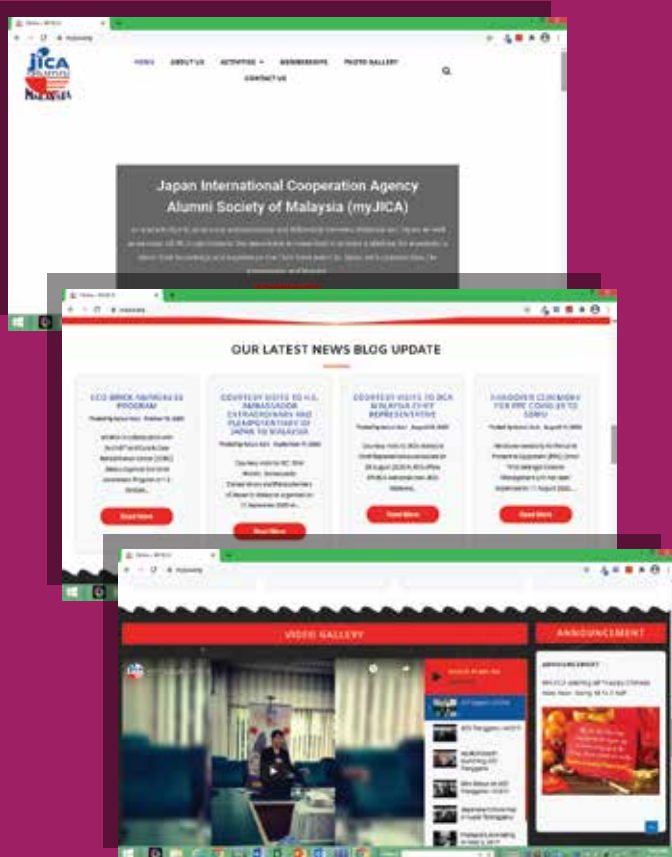

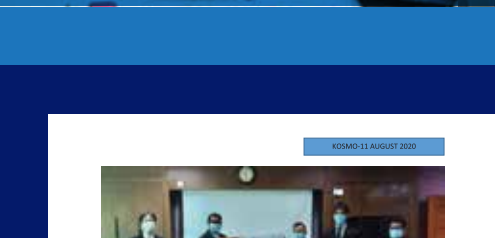

Alumni myJICA sumbang keperluan pencegahan Covid-19

SUKSES ALUMNI – Perutusan Alumni Agensi Kerjasama Antarabangsa Jepun Malaysia (myJICA) memberikan sumbangan keperluan pencegahan Covid-19 kepada kerajaan negeri melalui Unit Pengurusan Bencana Selangor (SDMU).

Antara keperluan pencegahan yang diberikan adalah 5,000 keping pelitup muka, 100 botol cecair pembasmi kuman dan 200 botol tablet Vitamin C.

Presiden myJICA, Norazul Abdul Aziz berkata, sumbangan tersebut adalah tanda sokongan perutusan tersebut kepada kerajaan negeri bagi membanteras gejala virus Covid-19.

"Kami memberi sumbangan keperluan pencegahan Covid-19 antaranya pelitup muka, cecair pembasmi kuman dan beberapa barangan lain.

"Kami berharap sumbangan ini mencukupi dan membantu dalam menambak bekalan SDMU perlukan dalam usaha mengawal pandemik Covid-19," katanya selepas majlis Sumbangan myJICA kepada SDMU di Bangunan Setiausaha Kerajaan Selangor di sini hari ini.

Sumbangan itu disampaikan Norazul kepada Ketua Penolong Setiausaha SDMU, Ahmad Fairuz Mohd. Yusoff.

Dalam perkembangan berlainan, Norazul berkata, sejumlah 20 aluminya yang telah berakhir di Kementerian Kesihatan sebagai manfaatkan pengisian dalam bidang perubatan.

Jelasnya, selain bidang perubatan, alumni myJICA turut terlibat dalam bidang pengajian lain dan kementerian dalam kerajaan.

"Kita-kira 5,000 alumni kami bekerja di Institut Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan (IOSH) dan beberapa agensi lain. Alumni ini turut membantu kerajaan Malaysia menangani Covid-19 seperti mengumpul data kes, menganalisis kes dan sebagainya.

"Kita merancang membuat siaran webinar secara langsung kepada untuk memberi kesedaran kepada orang ramai mengenai Covid-19," katanya. – KI ONLINE

Pihak yang berkaitan Perutusan Alumni MYJICA Sabah dan Kurus BAKTISISWA di Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) bekerjasama mengadakan Webinar Siri 3 yang bertajuk "THE JOURNEY IN DETERMINING PERSONAL GOALS" dengan tema "Edukasi, Stansi Awal, Saiz yang sedang meningkat Program Pengajian Doktor Falsafah di Iskandar University, Sijarah melalui laman "The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)". Perutusan perutusan adalah ahli Perutusan Alumni MYJICA Sabah akan memantapkan alumni program Great di Faculty Sains Sosial dan Kemasyarakatan (FSSS) UMS yang baharu akan ditubuhkan sebagai "Sains Sosial".

Program Webinar Siri 3 yang dijalankan pada awal bulan Januari 2021 adalah persembahan kepada sumbangan perutusan kepada komuniti di samping memantapkan hubungan kerjasama dengan institusi pengajian tinggi.
